Humane World for Animals South Africa is a South-African-registered animal welfare NGO that focuses on the protection of wild, farm and companion animals, as well as animals in bioscience research.

The main focus of the animals in bioscience research program is a commitment to scientific integrity through engagement with replacement technologies.

In recognition of SANS10386:2021 requirement for all ethics committees to include at least one member from Category C, with Category C & D together representing one-third of the AEC membership, Humane World has created an 'Animals in Science Unit' (ASU).

The ASU includes expert veterinary consultants in the field of scientific testing.

The ASU will:

- Support ARECs in ensuring best practical ethical oversight of the use of animals in science, through supportive engagement and training in the practical adoption of 4R's, harms benefit analysis, and the adoption of non-animal research models.
- Share up-to-date Replacement solutions for bioscience research and testing
- Match representatives to key ARECs based on experience and location.
- Offer Category C members at no cost to the AEC
